OVERVIEW

The School of Economics and Management of Beijing Forestry University was established in 1987, building upon a rich historical foundation that includes the Agriculture and Forest Programs of Imperial University of Peking established in 1902, the Forestry Economics Specialty of Beijing Forestry College in 1959, and its Department of Forestry Economics in 1982. Despite enduring challenges, dedicated forestry economic professionals never wavered from their original intentions and missions. Through their relentless efforts, the school has evolved into a leading institution with a well–structured discipline framework, distinctive educational features, and comprehensive strength. It has established a comprehensive talent development system, comprising undergraduate education as its primary focus, alongside postdoctoral, doctoral, master's, professional master's, and dual degree programs. From this high–calibre talent pool, over 20,000 well–rounded graduates have emerged, actively contributing to China's forestry development and ecological construction. Among them, numerous senior management talents, including six individuals at or above the deputy ministerial level, as well as internationally renowned experts and scholars emerged.

Currently, the school boasts more than 3,300 students, including 2,500 undergraduates and 800 domestic and international postgraduates, spread across nine departments encompassing 11 undergraduate specialties, 10 master's specialties and doctoral programs in the first-class disciplines of agriculture and forestry economics and management. The school comprises 158 faculty members, making it the most extensive in terms of disciplines, specialties and student enrollment compared to other schools within Beijing Forestry University.

The school has developed a distinctive structure with agricultural and forestry economics and management as its core, supported by applied economics, and industry & business management as the two auxiliary components. This pattern has fostered a symbiotic relationship among its characteristic disciplines and others in the field of economics and management, laying a solid foundation for the school's long-term sustainable development.

The discipline of agriculture and forestry economics and management, being one of the school's key and characteristic disciplines, plays an essential role in advancing the disciplines knowledge. The forestry economics and management discipline was granted the authority to confer a master's degree in 1984 and a doctoral degree in 1995, later earning recognition as the national key construction discipline under the "211 Project" by the Ministry of Education. After the school produced its first cohort of doctoral students in forestry economics and management in 1999, it received high-quality assessments during the ministry's evaluations for the first and second phases of the "211 Project" in 2001 and 2006, subsequently entering the third phase. In 2003, the school established the first group of postdoctoral mobile stations in agriculture and forestry economics and management. Four years later, the forestry economics and management discipline was designated a state-level key cultivation discipline, while its specialty agriculture and forestry economics and management earned recognition as both a state-level characteristic discipline by the Ministry of Education and a municipal-level characteristic one in Beijing. In the following year, its teachers were honoured with the "Outstanding Teaching Team" accolade in Beijing. In 2012 and 2016, twice the same discipline was ranked the eighth of the First-Level Disciplines in the country by the Discipline Evaluation Group of the Ministry of Education. In 2012, it was designated a key discipline of Beijing, and in 2015 agriculture and forestry economics and management once again received the distinction of being a key discipline of the State Forestry Administration. The discipline in 2018 achieved the title of a "double first-rate" key cultivation discipline by Beijing Forestry University.
