

### PREPARATORY PROGRAM

This program aims to provide a comprehensive and systematic Chinese learning environment for international students to help them improve their Chinese language proficiency and prepare them for major studies at undergraduate or graduate levels. The preparatory courses include comprehensive Chinese language, listening, speaking, reading and writing skills training, China's national conditions, etc. Meanwhile, the program also provides courses in mathematics, physics, chemistry, and business Chinese for students of different majors, which help students master the basic vocabulary of specialized Chinese language, and ensure that the students can integrate into China's higher education system smoothly. The preparatory program is usually a one-year program, and after completing the courses and passing the assessment, students can be directly admitted to undergraduate or postgraduate programs at BFU.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

**Applicants must** 

- be 17-24 years of age
   (A guardian authorization is required for those under 18 years old)
- have a valid ordinary passport
- hold high school/senior secondary diploma or equivalent

# VISITING STUDENT PROGRAM

The Visiting Student Program is a unique program allowing students to study at Beijing Forestry University for up to 2 academic years in regular academic courses, and even in Chinese language study. The program offers enhanced student support and advising, cultural, sports, leisure activities and events.

All courses at Beijing Forestry University are open to visiting students. Students who have completed the study plan will receive a completion certificate.

Applicants must

- be non-Chinese citizens between 18-60 years of age
- have received a high school graduation certificate
- hold a valid passport

#### **Language And Culture Program**

This program includes intensive Chinese language learning, as well as cultural and recreational activities. Learners have the opportunity to meet students from around the world and get to experience what it's like to study in China.

#### Chinese Language Learning Summer/Winter Camp

Annual Review is strictly required for all CGS holders according to the regulations of the CSC. The Annual Review includes academic performance, learning attitude, attendance, student conducts, rewards and punishments, etc.
