APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Step 1: The partner university emails us at admission@bjfu.edu.cn to specify the following nomination details:

- Student's name.
- Selected program (please select from the program list, and be aware of the language of instruction).
- Study duration
- Indicate whether the student will take courses and transfer credits only or conduct research with a supervisor.
- If the student has been invited by any BFU professor, please attach the invitation letter signed by the BFU professor. Step 2: The nominated student is required to complete application on BFU International Application Portal at bjfu.at0086.cn/student. Choose "Exchange Student Program" and provide the required application materials.

Notes:

- a. The application fee may required to be paid based on the exchange agreement between the two universities;
- b. Please monitor your application status regularly. Your application will proceed to the next stage after successful fee payment;
- c. Online application is the only way to submit your application. Hard copies are unacceptable.

APPLICATION DOCUMENS

- 1 passport photo
- Photocopy of valid ordinary passport
- Study proof issued by the home university (in Chinese or English)
- Original and notarized photocopies of official academic transcripts issued by home university
- · A recommendation letter written by a professor or an expert from the home univiersity
- Photocopy of Language Proficiency Certification (HSK4 or above is required for Chinese-taught programs; English Language Proficiency test result, e,g, IELTS with no less than 6.0 scores, TOFEL with no less than 80 scores, etc. is required for English-taught programs)
- Physical Examination Form (please use the standard version)
- Certified non-criminal record with a validity of no more than 6 months
- Other supporting documents (if you have any)
